

## **Nominations Sought for 2011 Van Bogard Dunn Ecumenical Award**

The Commission on Christian Unity and Interreligious Concerns (COCUIC) announces the opening of nominations for the 2011 Van Bogard Dunn Ecumenical Awards. Two awards are given annually, one to a layperson and one to a clergy member.

Nominees should be persons who have demonstrated concern for the unity of the Body of Christ (the Church) by involvement in local, district, conference, or ecumenical activities that promote unity and understanding between persons of different faiths or denominations.

Award recipients will receive a certificate signed by the Bishop and will be recognized in their local churches and in the ***East Ohio E-News***. Their names will be inscribed on a plaque on display in the Area Center. In addition, the Commission on Christian Unity and Interreligious Concerns will donate \$100 in the name of each award recipient to an ecumenical project of their choice.

For consideration for this year's award, nominations must be received no later than **March 31, 2011** and must be made on the nomination form on the back of this announcement (forms may be photocopied as necessary).
