

New London Grace Scholarship

This scholarship is for Black students in undergraduate studies in higher education from the East Ohio Annual Conference of the United Methodist Church.

Guidelines

- 1. A yearly scholarship for a Black student, or students, in undergraduate studies, in higher education*
- 2. The student(s) must be a member of a local church within the East Ohio Conference.*
- 3. Any qualified Black United Methodist student(s) from New London is to be given first preference.*
- 4. The funds are to be held in perpetuity by the Ohio East United Methodist Foundation, with the scholarship being recommended by the East Ohio Commission on Religion and Race Scholarship committee, or its successor.*

Students wishing to apply for the NEW LONDON GRACE SCHOLARSHIP should complete the **Religion and Race Scholarship Application Form and have it received at the Conference Office by March 31, 2012.** The amount of the scholarship will be determined each year by the Ohio East United Methodist Foundation.
