

2012 Health Care Premiums

The 2012 Health Care Premiums will remain the same as the 2010 - 2011 premiums with the exception of the Retiree Plans; retired less than age 65 – single will increase by 10% and retired secondary (Medicare Prime) – single, will increase by 5%.

Clergy – Flat Rate

Lay – (Active) Post 65 Secondary (Medicare Prime) – Single

Retired – less than age 65 – Single

\$491.00 per month

\$5,592.00 per year

Retired – Post 65 Supplemental (Medicare Prime) – Single

\$297.00 per month

\$3,564.00 per year

Retired Clergy: Conference premium-sharing policy

EOC clergy retirees who have 25 or more accumulative years of pension credit service funded by EOC pay 30% of their health care premiums. For service less than 25 accumulative years, the retiree pays 30% plus 2.8% for each year less than 25 years of service.

Example: Retired clergy person age 65 with 25 years pays 30% of the monthly base premium of \$297.00, which equals \$89.10 per month. (Retiree premium-sharing is applied on a per person basis.)
