Sponsor a Children's Sabbath, promoted by the Children's Defense Fund, by using the National Observance of Children's Sabbath Handbook-Repairers of the Breach #3224. Get involved with children by mentoring, tutoring, Big Sister Program, or Ohio Reads. Write, e-mail, or call Congressional representative and/or others in government regarding children's issues. Visit local schools and/or attend a school board meeting. Other (Explain)
