Dear Lay Member to Annual Conference:

One of the responsibilities you have as a Lay Member of Annual Conference – scheduled to meet at Lakeside, June 10 – 13, 2019 – will be the election of six (6) Lay Delegates to General Conference. Lay Members will also be electing six (6) additional Lay Delegates to Jurisdictional Conference and five (5) Reserve Delegates to the Jurisdictional Delegation. All of these Lay Delegates will join East Ohio Clergy delegates of equal number in representing East Ohio at General and Jurisdictional Conference in 2020. **This means that our total General Conference Delegation will have 12 persons, 6 lay and 6 clergy.** The Jurisdictional Delegation is larger; it will be comprised of a total of 24 persons. It will include the 12 elected to General Conference and an additional 12 lay and clergy elected to the Jurisdictional Conference.

I have enclosed for your careful review the biographies of the candidates endorsed by their Districts to stand for election as delegates to the General and Jurisdictional Conferences.

The process of these elections begins with an important Laity Session that will take place in Hoover Auditorium at 8:30 a.m. Monday morning, June 10, 2019. At this meeting nominations of candidates for election to General and Jurisdictional Conference will be taken from the floor. These lay nominees will join those lay candidates who have been nominated by their respective districts at the 10 District Conferences this spring. If you plan to nominate someone from the floor at the laity session please contact me for guidance.

Please read Conference Rule 7, ELECTION OF GENERAL AND JURISDICTIONAL DELEGATES, as found in The Pre-Conference Workbook. The rule details the process involved in electing Lay and Clergy Delegates to General and Jurisdictional Conferences. I hope you will read it and become familiar with this process. How you respond this summer will affect our church profoundly.

The Disciplinary qualifications required of any lay person before he or she is eligible to receive votes and/or be elected to General and Jurisdictional Conference can be found in the 2016 *Book of Discipline*, ¶ 34. It is quoted below.

¶ 36. Article V.—The lay delegates to the General and jurisdictional or central conferences shall be elected by the lay members of the annual conference or provisional annual conference without regard to age; provided such delegates shall have been professing members of The United Methodist Church for at least two years next preceding their election, and shall have been active participants in The United Methodist Church for at least four years next preceding their election, and are members thereof within the annual conference electing them at the time of holding the General and jurisdictional or central conferences.

Each candidate will be asked to affirm that he or she has met these qualifications.

Please bring this biographical material with you to Annual Conference. I pray that the peace of God be with each of you as we gather for our annual meeting at Lakeside.
