

Revelation 22:1-2

1 Then the angel showed me the river of the water of life, as clear as crystal, flowing from the throne of God and of the Lamb 2 down the middle of the great street of the city.

On each side of the river stood the tree of life, bearing twelve crops of fruit, yielding its fruit every month. And the leaves of the tree are for the healing of the nations.

Bible Teaching:

The book of Revelations is about visions God showed John when he was in prison for serving God. Here in chapter 22, John sees a vision of a river flowing from the throne of God. The throne is the place where God rules. The river is a symbol that represents God's rule flowing out through the city and land bringing food and healing everywhere it flows..

Discussion Questions:

- 1. Why are rivers important?
- 2. How do rivers help the communities they flow through?
- 3. How can following God's rules such as "Do not kill, do not steal, honor your mother and father", help a community be healthy or better?
- 4. Can you think of other rules of God that will help us and our community if we obey them?
- 5. What happens when the people don't follow God's rules?

- 1. Post a picture of your river on the BART page.(5 points)
- 2. Throw a small piece of wood or a leaf in the river and watch it float down stream. Take a picture or video and post it on BART. (5 points.)
- 3. Try skipping a flat stone across the river to the other side. Post a picture or video to BART. (5 points per child.)
- 3. Write down one rule of God that would make our community and better place if everyone followed it. Post it on BART.(5 points per child.)
