Lay Servant Ministries provides training opportunities and experiences to equip disciples of Jesus Christ to realize and respond to their personal calls to ministry. Each disciple has one or more spiritual gifts, skills given by the Holy Spirit for the express purpose of serving the body of believers and thereby God. Lay Servant Ministries aids disciples in recognizing their specific gifts by offering educational events to develop their unique skills. These trainings provide an excellent vehicle in which to develop one's servant ministry; helping church members to become better servants of Jesus Christ, stronger church leaders, and capable of assisting their pastors.

If you are sensing God's call to greater service in the church or would like to learn more about how you might serve, the "Basic" course offers an introduction to understanding your gifts, spiritual leadership, caring ministry, communication skills, and outreach. "Advanced" courses allow one to become a Certified Lay Servant or Lay Speaker in the East Ohio Conference.

Lay Servant Descriptions & Requirements:

Certified Lay Servant: *A lay person whom God has called to lay ministry in their local church and beyond.*

1. Has completed the 'Basic' course, **Lay Servant: Ministry: Serving, Learning and Leading**
2. Is a member of a United Methodist church.
3. Has taken one advanced course.
4. Applies to become a Certified Lay Servant after talking with his/her pastor and completes a Certified Lay Servant report, which also serves as a Certified Lay Servant application.
5. Receives the formal approval of his/her pastor and charge conference or /church council.
6. Files an annual Certified Lay Servant report (the year after he/she has applied and completed his/her first advanced LSM course).
7. Completes 1 advanced course every 3 years.

Certified Lay Speaker: *One who can provide pulpit supply, and serve in the local congregation and beyond.*

- Has pastor and charge conference approval.
- Completes six required courses for LS Certification.
- Interviews with the District LSM Committee.
- Is approved by the EOC LSM Committee.
- Files an annual certified lay speaker report.
- Completes one advanced course every 3 years and interviews with the District LSM Committee.

Certified Lay Minister (CLM): *One who serves with a Mutual Ministry Covenant in the local church and beyond under supervision and part of a Ministry Team.*
