On the days when I felt overwhelmed and terrified at the prospect of becoming a district superintendent, I would ask myself, What's the worst that can happen? I decided that if it turned out I was a terrible DS, then the worst that would happen is that the Bishop would say, "Sorry, you're just not cut out for this—back to a local church for you!" That would be a terrific worst case scenario, because pastoring a church is the hard but joyful work to which I feel God has called me.

I came to the Mahoning Valley at God's call through Bishop Malone. While some wish she'd exercised that throwback option, I have personally experienced the confirmation of the Holy Spirit many times that this is where and when God wanted me to be. I've made plenty of mistakes and also witnessed God working in amazing ways. Many of you have heard me say that sometimes when I get whiny—"God, I can't believe THIS is my job!"—I can more or less hear God say, "Didn't you promise to do whatever I needed you to do?...Well, ok, then: THIS is what I need you to do for my church right now!" Then there are those moments when I've been so overwhelmed with gratitude that all I can say is, "God, I can't believe you allowed me to be part of THIS!"

The standard term for a district superintendent is six years. I will finish year six in June. When I had my annual consultation with Bishop Malone, I shared with her that I would like to be considered for local church appointment again, with her blessing. I love the Mahoning Valley. I've poured my heart into so much here. I am going to miss so many people and things here. But my heart feels tugged back to the local church. Being a district superintendent is a call for a season. I've done my best during this season, and it is drawing to a close.

We announced last month Bishop Malone's intention to appoint me to Strongsville UMC as of July 1, 2023. The district leadership board is representing you very well in working with her on the next chapter for the Mahoning Valley. Following another meeting later this month, there will be a public announcement regarding the Mahoning Valley district superintendency in late February. I invite all of us to pray as we wait for news.

Meanwhile, I will continue to serve as your district superintendent to the best of my ability, by God's grace. I look forward to many bittersweet goodbyes over the next few months as we continue to invest in God's work all over the Valley!

This April will be the 60th Anniversary of Dr. King writing the letter.

A few weeks after Dr. King wrote the letter, children in Birmingham were arrested, blasted with fire hoses and attacked by vicious dogs as they left the Sixteenth Street Baptist Church to march to downtown Birmingham asking for an end to segregated facilities in the downtown area. Present with us on April 17th will be **Janice Wesley Kelsey**, who was one of those "children", who was arrested and spent several days in jail.




