
In the next few months, there will be more information forthcoming about district structure, leadership, office locations, staffing, and more.

We Pray for Peace

United Methodists are saddened by the significant loss of life caused by the ongoing violence and we pray for peace in the Holy Land. We continue to pray for those who have lost family members and livelihoods, the injured, for those who perpetuate violence and for World Leaders that they may work for peace, the churches and all religious leaders and for those who work for peace in the region.

We know the situation is complicated, and we recognize the fear and sense of injustice that is felt, but we call on both sides not to resort to further violence and to engage in negotiation to establish a peace-ful solution for all who live in the Holy Land. As Christians, "we believe war is incompatible with the teachings and example of Christ. We therefore reject war as an instrument of national foreign poli-cy." (2016 Book of Discipline, Social Principles ¶165.C)

UMCOR has awarded an emergency grant to a local partner who used the funds to procure and distribute 300 hygiene kits for internally displaced people in Gaza. UMCOR is working with partners in Israel to provide humanitarian relief there as well.
