

The 2016 *Book of Discipline* no longer uses "Local (Basic) Lay Servant." Persons completing the Basic course will not need to complete an annual report for charge conferences. Persons are encouraged to take the Basic course as a step toward discerning a call to ministry that may include becoming a Certified Lay Servant. A certification of completion is issued upon completing the Basic course. Persons may apply to become Certified Lay Servants after completion of both Basic and an Advanced course.
