### Regrouping in the Wake of Disaffiliation

The Launchpad course has been around since 2010, equipping hundreds of United Methodist new start leaders. Launchpad does not prescribe a set timeline for planting a new church - but flexibly adaptable to multiple scenarios, from mergers to parachute drops, to second campuses to groups coming together in the wake of church disaffiliations. Launchpad 2023 focuses on all of the seasons that occur in the emergence of a healthy new church: Grieving, Discerning, Gathering, Loving/Serving, Visioning, Discipling, and Worshiping.

Launchpad 2023 is specialized around the challenges of forming new churches and fellowships arising from the disaffiliation crisis in the UMC. It is being offered digitally to enable ease of participation without travel, to as many persons as possible, at a minimal cost (\$395 for a team of up to five). Sessions will be held across five consecutive Thursday afternoons, from 4-6:30 p.m., starting on July 20 and concluding on Aug. 17, 2023.

#### **Virtual ERT Recertification Class**

The West Ohio Conference will host a virtual Early Response Team recertification training <u>using Zoom on July 29 from 9a - 1p</u>. The four-hour course will be taught by West Ohio ERT trainers and is approved by United Methodist Committee on Relief (UMCOR). Registrants must complete a background check and submit a photo prior to the training to participate. The class is only for West Ohio and East Ohio ERTs who have already completed the eight-hour basic course and need recertification, which needs to be completed every three years. Each year, a new chaplain hits the trail to build relationships and share the love of God through <u>Appalachian Trail Chaplaincy</u>. One chaplain's devotions below and more in his book," <u>On the Trail w/Chappy</u> Jack: Devotions for the Path You're On"

**Look**: Go outside or gaze out of your window. What's the smallest thing you see? The biggest? Take a moment to marvel at God's creativity and your own place in creation. Read Scripture: Psalm 96:11-12

**Hear**: Begin each day sitting on the porch, listening to the birds and soaking in the quiet stillness of the morning. Read: John 10:27-30

**Taste**: Pack a simple snack or meal and find a picnic spot. Eat slowly, with intention, and savor each bite. Give thanks for your surroundings, the food and anyone who might be with you. Read: Psalm 23

**Smell**: Sit outside for several minutes and close your eyes. Take a few deep breaths. What do you smell? Try to identify more than one scent. Read Scripture: 2 Corinthians 2: 14-17

**Touch**: Plant a seed. Hold the dirt. Get muddy. Care for your new plant over time and touch the leaves. Think about growth cycle and how you might emulate it in your spiritual life. Read: Genesis 1:9-12
