## New/Gently Used Items

**Toiletry Items-** toilet paper, shampoo, conditioner, soap, toothbrushes, sanitary napkins

**Cleaning Supplies-** dish soap, bathroom/kitchen cleaner, sponges, cleaning rags, paper towels, laundry detergent, trash cans, mops, brooms, trash bags, laundry detergent

**Linens/Household Supplies-** bath towels, set of sheets (twin, full, queen), pillows, light bulbs, blankets, plunger

**Kitchen Supplies-** utensils, dishes, pots & pans, mixing bowls, kitchen utensils (spatula, knives, serving utensils, wooden spoons), can openers

### Tier 1



Have an empty property, apartment, or community space you're looking to rent to a new family? Know people who do? Partner with The Refugee Response in sponsoring a newly arriving families. This includes assisting in locating an apartment in Cleveland and furnishing, stocking, and setting up housing with our checklist provided.

The Refugee Response will help put calls out for furniture donations, connect with a resettlement agency, help coordinate delivery of furniture, and liaison between landlord-tenant-agency. We will host Refugee 101 training and arrange a welcome party two weeks after arrival

### Welcome Team! (2 month commitment)

Be the rapid deployment welcome team to recruit volunteers, transport furniture, set up houses, stock basic pantry items, and welcome the family to their new home.

The Refugee Response will liaise between agency and team, coordinate the schedule, host Refugee 101 training, provide other support to family and organize a welcome party after 2 weeks with the welcome team.
