Agency Programs and Services:

(serving residents of Knox County; all services are dependent on availability; income guidelines apply – at/below 200% FPG)

- Program Name: Clothing Assistance (supplies may be limited)
- Description: One (1) complete outfit provided free of charge for each individual or family member once every 30 days. When available, coats, hats and gloves are also provide.
- Program Name: Food Pantry – **Every \$1.00 donated purchases \$9.50 worth of food thru the Mid-Ohio Foodbank!**
- Description: A variety of wholesome, healthy food is available once every 30 days. Individuals and families receive the basic ingredients for 3 meals for 3 days – a total of 9 meals. Taxable items, when available, are also included. All locations are Customer Choice Pantries.
- Program Name: Financial Aid/Discretionary Fund
- Description: Assistance is available a maximum of two times per year for those with disconnect notices on utilities. Rent and/or deposit assistance is also available. We also assist with health-maintenance prescriptions, and gasoline vouchers for out-of-county medical appointments. Prescription assistance and gasoline vouchers maybe available once every 60 days.
- Program Name: Turn the Tide
- Description: A Christmas event that includes three programs: holiday food basket distribution, Tree of Sharing, and Adopt-a-Family. Established clients may sign-up for assistance with the holiday in October.
- Other Services: Kiwanis “Coats for Kids” distribution, AEP’s Neighbor-to-Neighbor Assistance Program
- We also provide a worksite for court-appointed community service workers and the Work Experience Program (WEP).
