

A SERVANT ON A 3:12 PROJECT

1. When groups come to a 3:12 Project we ask them to come with a servant attitude.
 - A servant has a positive attitude.
 - A servant is willing to pitch in and help wherever and whenever needed.
 - A servant realizes that God is seeking to work through her/him and that God is seeking to bless another through her/his personality and efforts.
2. 3:12 Projects represent 3R's -- Reach, Rebuild and Restore.
 - We “share our witness” as followers of Christ, and we “enrich relationships” with those we serve, with others, and through strengthening our own relationship with God.
 - *"And may the Lord make you increase and abound in love for one another and for all people" (1 Thessalonians 3:12)*
3. Remember to be flexible, friendly and caring.
 - Pitch in when you can.
 - Be patient when there is downtime.
 - Remember to treat all persons with care and respect at all times.
 - Please be flexible and patient as to not get bent out of shape. This is a good way to make new friends and further build relationships.

5. Group Leaders:
 - Most repairs can be done in several ways. Please have a careful understanding of the task needing accomplished. Resources are often limited. Consult with others ahead of time to determine the best plan for your project.
 - Remember that you set the tone for your group. We ask that you be flexible and understanding. We recognize your role and responsibilities, but if the unpredictable should happen, let's work through it together. There may be some downtime and things may not go as smoothly as anticipated. Weather cannot be controlled so please be patient if inclement weather should occur.
 - Your group is responsible for devotions the day of your project, preferably just prior to beginning work. You are encouraged to have the group watch for a moment when they see Jesus during the work project. Please close with devotions at the end of the day.
