

Here are the registration costs for 2025. The registration form is ATTACHED to this email. Please use a SEPARATE REGISTRATION FORM for EACH individual attending.

- A. Double Occupancy Dorm room: \$160.00 housing, and meals included.
- B. Single Occupancy Dorm room: \$200.00 housing, and meals included.
- C. Commuter: \$100.00 -meals included.

You may commute from home or from a nearby hotel. You must make your own reservation. Nearby hotels are Holiday Inn Express & Suites, Hampton Inn & Suites, Comfort Inn and America Best Value Inn. Please make reservations early.

- D. Children: \$125.00 inclusive based on double occupancy. Completed Kindergarten 6th grade.
 - a. Children must be accompanied by an adult registered for the adult study.
- E. Youth: \$125.00 inclusive based on double occupancy. Completed $7^{th} 12^{th}$ grade.
 - a. Children must be accompanied by an adult registered for the adult study.
