

Spiritual Direction is a sacred opportunity to draw into a deeper relationship with God.



In Spiritual direction you reflect deeply on God, on yourself and on your experiences in daily life. Noticing God's presence and grace in your life in new ways, you are encouraged to listen to your deeper longings and open yourself to God's love and healing.

Benefits of Spiritual Direction

- Incorporate more spirituality into your daily routine.
- Talk with someone about spiritual experiences or thoughts.
- Discern God's will when facing a difficult decision.
- Listen more carefully and see more clearly God's presence in your life.
- Face challenges grounded in God's love and grace.
- Voice your hopes, struggles and questions of faith in confidentiality.



Meeting with a Spiritual Director

A spiritual director serves as your spiritual companion - walking with you as you journey into a deeper relationship with God. This can take place in confidential one-on-one meetings, or small group settings. The image of three chairs reminds us of the presence of the Holy Spirit along with the directee and director during spiritual direction.



Most spiritual directors have rigorous training in spiritual direction and spiritual disciplines. They continue to grow in their own spiritual life through prayer, continuing education, supervision and meeting with their own spiritual director.

During your initial contact, you will set a time and place to meet that is convenient for both of you. Usually meetings take place monthly and last an hour. Sometimes people meet for a specific purpose or to complete a set of spiritual exercises. Note that spiritual direction is not the same as clinical and pastoral counseling. There is usually a fee for spiritual direction, which varies with each director.

Finding a Spiritual Director

The East Ohio Conference is graced to have certified spiritual directors within our communion. These trained spiritual directors work with both clergy and laity to help deepen and widen your connection with God.
