Founded in 2003, we have recently incorporated our ministry. We are now LIBERIA FARMER TO FARMER MINISTRY and are in the process of obtaining 501c3 tax exempt status. This is an exciting time for our ministry in Harrisburg Liberia.

The Mission of LIBERIA FARMER TO FARMER MINISTRY is to assist the people of Harrisburg, Liberia to enhance their farming productivity by using technology and mechanization, and to provide education, training, and basic skills to the community to support a sustainable future focused on agriculture.

We have established a United States Board of Trustees that will work closely with leaders in Harrisburg to share needs and information as well as encouragement and fellowship. We hope to send more mission teams as soon as it is safe and healthy to do so. We recently had a virtual mission team experience with the Youth Group at Strongsville UMC.

As in all countries, education is key to greater opportunities, better futures, financial stability and family security. Farmer to Farmer is committed to provide opportunities for Harrisburg residents to obtain a basic education, to learn life skills, and to learn how to provide a better life for their families. We have:

- ♦ completed building the structures for an elementary school and a high school. We will continue to furnish these buildings and empower the current staff to continue building enrollment and adding new teachers. We are fund-raising for a middle school to complete the campus. Our campus buildings will also enable an adult education program.
- ♦ introduced several farm initiatives, including raising chickens, new ways to grow cassava (a Liberia staple), corn and other crops.
- ♦ continued our Girls of Promise scholarship program so that girls in Harrisburg will have an equal opportunity for education.
- ♦ a Women's Empowerment Center that includes a sewing center for local women to learn to sew for those beyond their families and have been sewing school uniforms.
