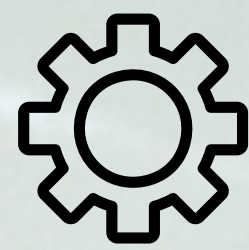

Discipleship, Community + Servant Leadership

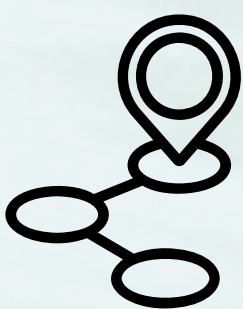

DISCIPLESHIP → LEADERSHIP PATHWAY



HOW IT WORKS:

- Students stay rooted in their own local church.
- Youth Groups participate by forming a CYC Hub or partnering with a nearby host church.
- Together, students across East Ohio journey through the same six-session discipleship pathway, connecting through shared learning, worship, conversation, and servant leadership.
- Designed to be an *opt-in*, not an *add-on*, the CYC can fit naturally into existing Youth Group rhythms, strengthening, not competing with, local church ministry.



A MOVEMENT OF DISCIPLESHIP

The Conference Youth Collective is built on a simple idea: students grow deepest when discipleship is practiced locally, but they grow stronger when they know they aren't walking alone. As churches across East Ohio explore the same discipleship pathway, students live out their faith in their own churches, schools, and communities. Along the way, relationships grow, creating opportunities for churches, hubs, and students to collaborate through service, retreats, camps, and other shared experiences.
