Enclosed is a Youth Service Fund (YSF) Project Application from the East Ohio Conference of The United Methodist Church. Ministry areas dealing with youth are invited to apply for funding. The application deadline is **Monday**, **April 5**, **2021**. The application must be postmarked by that date.

Projects are selected on the following criteria: the project must be youth-related, and youth initiated.

(Youth are 12-18 years of age in the US or up to 30 years old for international projects)

- YSF money is to be used to develop projects that will become self- supporting. (Individual programs will not be supported for more than 3 years in a row)
- YSF grants are not to be used to fund a deficit, or personnel.
- Projects must not discriminate against participants in any way.

Projects are reviewed and selected by the YSF team, which is made up of our missions' team. Their recommendations are then voted on by the CCYM body as a whole. Final approval is given at YAC. The funds approved at YAC 2021 will be disbursed in July of 2021.
